

## Graduate Certificate of Ministry Development

The Graduate Certificate of Ministry Development is an award intended for enabling the ministry of clergy to be enhanced in facets of ministry that are best developed while in the practice of vocational ministry. The award is a four-unit, part-time course that can be completed in a minimum of two years, i.e. one unit per semester. All units are offered only in intensive on-campus delivery mode. The course is not available to international students.

As Moore College is the Sydney Anglican Diocesan training College, this graduate certificate seeks to build on the theological convictions of the Anglican Diocese of Sydney. It provides support for the student to better engage in self-care and self-development, and also in assisting them to develop the ministry capability of others.
