JOAN AUGUSTA MACKENZIE TRAVELLING SCHOLARSHIP 2019

This Scholarship was established by the Will of the late Miss Joan Augusta Mackenzie, who died in 1968, to enable clergymen, who would not otherwise be able to do so, to study overseas. Perpetual Trustee Company Ltd is the trustee of the trust. The Scholarship is awarded by the Trustee in consultation with the Principal of Moore Theological College, Newtown, Sydney and the Rector of St Thomas Church of England, North Sydney. Candidates may be invited to an interview.

The Scholarship:

- 1. is to enable the recipient to study and/or gain experience in parish work either in the United Kingdom or such other country or countries as may be approved;
- 2. is open to clergymen who;
 - (i) have been educated in Australia;
 - (ii) have served for not less than two years since ordination as Deacon; and
 - (iii) intend to return to Australia at the end of the Scholarship period;
- 3. is awarded for the usual period of the postgraduate degree for which the recipient intends to enrol, to commence at such date as may be approved;
- 4. has a total value of \$30,000 each year for the usual period of the postgraduate degree (normally up to three years), paid either in instalments or a lump sum as the Trustees see fit;
- 5. is usually awarded to commence at the end of the preceding Scholarship period.

A Scholarship recipient must provide to the Trustee, each twelve months, (and at such other times as the Trustee may require), a report of his studies and ecclesiastical activities. If, at any time, the Trustee is not satisfied that the recipient is complying with the terms of the Scholarship the Trustee may terminate the Scholarship.

Applications should include the following information – no longer than 3 pages:

- (i) Name, address and telephone number or email address
- (ii) Details of education and qualifications and any current course of study
- (iii) Details of work since ordination as a Deacon
- (iv) Details of the course of study, and general plans if awarded the Scholarship
- (v) Names and address of three referees as to educational and other qualifications.
