

Advanced Diploma of Bible, Mission and Ministry Course Structure

The Advanced Diploma of Bible, Mission and Ministry comprises ten units of study. Students may choose between four strands of specialisation or not elect a specialisation and choose units from across all available Core Specialisation Units. It is mandatory to study either Overview of Church History (CT125) or Philosophy: An Orientation to Theological Reflection and Communication (CT111)⁴.
