



From the Principal...

Over the next semester in the College chapel, I am preaching through the Book of Revelation. In that context I have once again come across one of the most fascinating descriptions of Christian prayer. Twice in Revelation we read about bowls full of incense, or the smoke of the incense that rises before the throne of God, and we are told the bowls "are the prayers of the saints" and the incense arises "with the prayers of the saints" (Rev. 5:8; 8:4).

Whatever else this little phrase in Revelation means, it indicates that the prayers of the saints are part of the worship of God in heaven. God's fragile but faithful people addressing God as Father, praising him, interceding for others, crying out for his help and strength — all of this is testimony to the wisdom and the glory of God. The prayers of God's people are precious to him and they play a crucial role in the heavenly celebration of God's character and saving acts.

We readily experience the fragility of our prayers. They sometimes seem so very weak. Paul reminds us that we do not even know what to pray as we ought (Rom. 8:26). Our perspective is often clouded by our circumstances and our confidence that God will answer our prayers is not constant. We can think we know the best way forward when God's plan and purpose is different, more long-term, and infinitely better. But our prayers are very significant, not simply for us as we walk in dependence upon our heavenly Father, but in the glorious drama of heaven. The incense that rises before God in the heavenly temple is the prayers of the saints.

So as you pray for us at Moore College in this next quarter, I hope you'll be encouraged by the heavenly perspective that is given to us in the Book of Revelation. As the curtain is pulled back for a moment to reveal what is really going on in the world, our prayers are significant.

Focus for September:


- Term 4 Commences
