

From the Principal...

I have often been struck by the words of lesus to the disciples in the last week of his life, when they asked him about "the close of the age": "And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come" (Matt. 24:14). It is a powerful reminder that the global gospel mission has a critical role in the history of the entire universe. All things are to be brought under the rule of Christ and the way God has chosen to achieve this is through the proclamation of "the gospel of the kingdom".

It is all too easy for us to be short-sighted when it comes to the gospel mission. We can be almost exclusively concerned with our community and our strategy for reaching our neighbours. Such a concern is right and good. God has placed us in this place at this time with the opportunity to reach these people. But if this is all we see and we don't lift our eyes to see the vast scope of God's plan and our mission we can miss the mind-blowing scale of God's love and sacrifice at the cross, let alone lose sight of the great destination of God's purpose: the multi-racial, multi-lingual gathering around the throne of God and the Lamb (Rev. 7:9-12). As a friend of mine once said to me, "We're better when we're not thinking or talking about ourselves!"

One of my annual joys at Moore College is our College Graduation, in which our graduates not only receive their degree certificates but the assembled throng get to hear where they have gone to serve the mission and God's people. To hear of men and women going to the Pacific Islands, Asia, Africa, the Middle East, Europe, North and South America is wonderfully exciting. This little College on the edge of the world is being used by God to further his plan of providing "a testimony to all nations".

In this issue of our Prayer Bulletin we get an opportunity to pray for those students who are leaving us and going onto the global mission field. In Sydney, rural Australia, other capital cities and around the world — Moore College graduates are loving the Lord, loving the Lord's word, and loving the Lord's people. Isn't that a wonderful thing to hear of and pray about? Thank you for praying.

Week 1: Friday, 1 December - Sunday, 10 December


- Give thanks for the many godly and gifted **students** at College and pray that what they


