BULLETIN

This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. (Psalm 118:24 ESV)

When I was growing up, we used to sing this verse as a chorus. What a good thing to do. And we were encouraged to view every day as a day that God had made, and one that we should be thankful for. Which is, of course, absolutely true. True, but a tragically impoverished distraction from the main point of this great verse in the context of the Psalm in which we find it. Our joy and gladness will be so much deeper and richer if we appreciate the day that is being described here.

The day Psalm 118 describes, and indeed the day God has gifted each one of us with is the day when the Lord himself has become our salvation and has made the stone that the builders rejected to be the cornerstone (vs 21-22). In doing this, he has opened wide the gate of righteousness (vs 19) that we might not die but live (vs 17). This is the day of the Lord Jesus (cf. 1 Pet 2:6-10), and everyone who comes in his name is blessed (vs 26-27). What a day!

So, on this day, let us rejoice and be glad in what the Lord has done. Let us be people marked out by thankfulness, for God is so good, and his steadfast love endures forever (vs 28-29).

I am so grateful that you are joining us in prayer to this good and loving heavenly Father. College is facing some challenges with building expenses, and staff shortages bring different kinds of pressures to bear. In a community of our size there are always sicknesses, griefs and complications to contend with. We covet your prayers for all of these things. As we pray though, let's remember to bring to mind this great day that the Lord has made, and remember to rejoice and be glad.
