FROM THE PRINCIPAL



2024 has been a year of answered prayer. We welcomed a large first year and we will welcome an even larger one in 2025. We have been able to appoint three new members of the College Faculty. The College missions went extraordinarily well, we were glad to welcome back visiting speakers to some of our events, and the second year of the new curriculum has been rolled out quite smoothly. We have had a series of Alumni Days in which those who have been out in ministry for a considerable period of time testified to the way the College has prepared them well for the ministry the Lord has entrusted to them.

We continue to see the way deep immersion in the Bible, mentoring and pastoral care, a focus on gospel ministry, and conversation with those who have gone before us seeking to understand the Scriptures, has helped grow our students into thoughtful, effective gospel ministers. Learning together in a cohort-based community makes a palpable difference.
