



### From the Principal...

Incline your ear, O LORD, and answer me, for I am poor and needy. Preserve my life, for I am godly; save your servant, who trusts in you—you are my God. Be gracious to me, O LORD, for to you do I cry all the day. Gladden the soul of your servant, for to you, O LORD, do I lift up my soul. For you, O LORD, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you. Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace. In the day of my trouble I call upon you, for you answer me.

This prayer of David is a wonderful encouragement to pray. David understands his own poverty before God. He might be godly but he is not sinless. He knows his plea is always a request for grace. But he also knows that God is good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon him.

These two things come together in David's prayer: a right assessment of himself and a right assessment of the God to whom he prays. He cannot demand; he has no basis for such presumption. He can only pray that the LORD might answer his prayer. But he is confident that God will, because God sees his need and because God is gracious.

Living on this side of the cross gives us additional confidence. Like David we know that God is gracious, that he is good and forgiving, and that he abounds in steadfast love. We too know that, left to ourselves, we would be lost and in desperate need for forgiveness and grace. But we know the only sure anchor for the forgiveness and grace we need. Jesus, the one who embodies these things has come, and he prays for us.

We don't have to become worthy before we can pray to our heavenly Father. We are invited to pray and he is good and forgiving. Thank you for your prayers in support of the College. Thank you too for your prayers for gospel ministry in Sydney, across Australia and around the world. The need is very great and those whom the Lord raises up to meet it do desperately need the kind of theological training that the College provides if they are to sustain a word ministry over the long haul. So please keep praying, and don't forget to drop us a line and let us know how we can pray for you.



### Week 2: Monday, 4 July - Sunday, 10 July


- Jess Dunn (1st year) Praise God for the opportunity to study at College full time. Pray


# Week 4: Monday, 18 July - Sunday, 24 July
