



From the Principal...

Thank you for your prayers for the College during this COVID-19 season. In God's kindness, we have been able to continue operating as a college, albeit in a slightly different way. Communication and information technology have enabled us to keep teaching. E-books and e-journals have enabled students and faculty to continue their research and study. Pastoral care and one-on-one follow-ups have been stepped up, again made possible by MS Teams, Zoom and other computer applications.

While the situation remains volatile and could change at any moment, as I write this we are in the middle of a phased return of students to on-campus, face-to-face learning. Every step of this return has been a matter of earnest prayer. There are certainly new challenges in doing this, but we are acting with extreme caution. Our love for each other, for the staff, faculty, students and visitors demands nothing less. Please pray for all the logistics associated with social distance, accountability, and the other components of our COVID Safe Plan.

We have begun planning for life on the other side of this pandemic. One thing is clear: this exercise has strengthened rather than lessened our commitment to the full-time residential model of theological education and ministry formation that is one of the great distinctives of Moore College. We will need to follow our new safety precautions and procedures for quite some time I suspect (no one has a clear idea of when this crisis will be over). Yet the Lord has never given up on his purposes. We must be proactive in planning for the future, seeking to be faithful stewards of what God has entrusted to us, but above all else we pray. It is the Lord who is sovereign in this. That is why we are so very grateful for your partnership in prayer. Thank you.

Will you keep praying with me that the Lord will do something amazing through all this dislocation? As people all over the world are confronted by their mortality and vulnerability, may many more people come to know what we know in the gospel:

Jesus ... is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them. (Hebrews 7:25)
