Overview of PTC study

All students are given access to the Online Learning Environment (OLE) which contains the online PTC course materials, including online PTC notes and quizzes and feedback.

Students can Enrol and/or Subscribe to study. The differences between Enrolment and Subscription study are shown below. Either or both options can be chosen.

PTC Enrolment	PTC Subscription
6-month enrolment in 1 PTC unit	One-year subscription to all online PTC units.
Full online access to enrolled unit, starting from the date you choose. Online exam can be done anytime within the 6-month enrolment period. Exam results with feedback (for online units)	Online non-enrolled (reading) access to all PTC units. No exams. No formal recognition of PTC study. Does not lead to PTC award.

Printed PTC notes option



If you prefer a printed copy of the PTC notes, these are available for purchase.

Paper exam option

An online exam is included in every enrolment, however you are able to purchase a Paper exam if you prefer. The Paper exam will be sent directly to students within 2 months of your enrolment beginning and can be completed any time during your 6-month enrolment.

Assessment

Assessment is normally one 90-minute exam of 60 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ).
The PTC units which are not online have Short Answer Questions instead.
Assessment is based on the content of the PTC notes only.
