3 The set book for BS411, BS412 may vary depending on the Faculty member who teaches the unit.
4 The BTh average must be, at minimum, 72.5% over the first three years of study to qualify for the
CT499 Project. The CT499 Project is required for direct entry to the MTh or PhD.
5 Students who complete Hebrew 1B but do not wish to continue with Hebrew in second year will
enrol in a designated alternative unit to TOTE A in Semester 1 and then take TOTE B in Semester 2.
